

about access to, a broad range of family planning methods and services: Provided further, That in awarding grants for natural family planning under section 104 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 no applicant shall be discriminated against because of such applicant's religious or conscientious commitment to offer only natural family planning; and, additionally, all such applicants shall comply with the requirements of the previous proviso: Provided further, That for purposes of this or any other Act authorizing or appropriating funds for foreign operations, export financing, and related programs, the term ``motivate'', as it relates to family planning assistance, shall not be construed to prohibit the provision, consistent with local law, of information or counseling about all pregnancy options including abortion: Provided further, That nothing in this subsection shall be construed to alter any existing statutory prohibitions against abortion under section 104 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961: Provided further, That of the funds appropriated under this heading, not less than the amount equal to the amount made available for the Office of Population of the Agency for International Development in fiscal year 1994 shall be made available to that office: Provided further, That the Administrator of the Agency for International Development may decrease that amount only if he consults with and provides a written justification to the Committees on Appropriations: Provided further, That such justification shall be considered in accordance with the regular notification procedures of the Committees on Appropriations.
